Re: COVID-19 Funding for Local Public Health Departments

Dear Governor Wolf and Secretary Levine,

The Pennsylvania Health Policy Coalition represents the state's ten county and municipal health departments. The Coalition is following up on its April 27, 2020 letter urgently requesting funding to support COVID-19 response funding in order to safely reopen the Commonwealth's economy. The Coalition is disappointed that it received no response to that letter.

Since the April 27 letter, the Coalition has learned that the Commonwealth has received grants from the CDC totaling \$344,794,856, including a recent award of \$301,036,686. To date, the Commonwealth has distributed just \$10,000,000, or 2.9 percent of CDC funds received, to Coalition members.

This small funding distribution is despite the fact that the ten Coalition members represent over 40 percent of the state's population and over 55 percent of the state's COVID-19 cases. Coalition members are expected to expand contact tracing, increase laboratory testing, and protect vulnerable populations, including nursing home residents, yet members have received just 2.9 percent of the funding allocated to the Commonwealth.

The Coalition is aware that Philadelphia County has received direct funding from the CDC of \$92,417,870 for testing and contact tracing.¹ By considering that funding, Coalition members in total have still received just 26 percent of the total funding allocated to the state, or less than half than it should receive based on population or case count allocation methodologies.

It is our understanding that the Coalition expects our ten jurisdictions to support and implement the Commonwealth's reopening plan. But that support requires resources, and it requires resources urgently. When will the Commonwealth be distributing appropriate funding to all ten Coalition members for our COVID-19 public health response activities?
